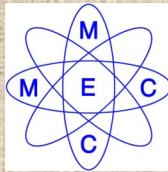




Marshall's Billfish Club

Total Qualifying Points Fishing Tournament March 9, 2013



Tournament Objective: To catch; Tag and release; and have the most qualifying points after all qualifying pounds have been converted to points. All categories of fish listed are eligible. Jackie Jacob Prize carry over for the biggest qualifying "dead" billfish. Just to refresh those who may have forgotten how the points system works.

Fish must be in good condition in order to qualify. Shark bitten or mutilated fish will be disqualified.

WEIGHTED FISH

Points are awarded on the basis of a point per pound for any fish that meets the qualifying pounds, legally caught, in the following categories:

1. Billfish - 100 pounds minimum.
2. Sailfish - 50 pounds minimum.
3. Tuna - 40 pounds minimum.
4. Wahoo - 25 pounds minimum.
5. Mahi - 15 pounds minimum
6. Barracuda - 15 pounds minimum.
7. Giant Trevally - 15 pounds minimum (MBC Tournament only).

LINE CLASS POINTS

- 50 lbs test line - 2 points per qualifying pound.
- 80 lbs test line - 1.5 points per qualifying pound.
- 130 lbs test line - 1 point per qualifying pound.

BONUS POINTS

- 2 points per pound for qualifying fish taken on 50 lbs test line.
- 100 points for billfish weighing over 500 pounds or heavier.
- 100 points for catch 5 in any tournament.

TAG AND RELEASE

Any pacific blue or black marlin and sailfish regardless of weight tagged will be awarded points plus 100 pounds for marlin and 50 pounds for sailfish:

- 50 lbs (24Kg) test line - 250 points (All Micronesian 200 points)
- 80 lbs (37) test line - 250 points (All Micronesian 200 points)
- 130 lbs (60Kg) test line - 250 points (All Micronesian 200 points)

Tuna any weight class 15 points per fish (2 fish maximum per tournament).

Nine boats entered into the Total Points fishing tournament and here are the results. Congratulations to team True Blue Capt. Kyle Aliven for the fourth time catching all five species earning 100 bonus points. They also tagged and release a marlin earning 250 points and winning the Total Points derby. Also congratulations to team Bubu Mira Capt. Chris deBrum for catching a 120 lbs. Pacific Blue Marlin winning the Jackie Jacob carry over prize money. They also caught a 24 lbs. Mahi Mahi. Team Kirtaki also Tagged and released a marlin and weighing in two Mahi mahi at 15 & 16 lbs. They also caught a 29 lbs. wahoo. Team Dragon Capt Bwiji Aliven also Tagged and Released a marlin and weighed in 2 mahi at 20 & 17 lbs. Team Carolina Capt Nicky deBrum also Tagged & Released a marlin and weighed in a 24 lbs. Mahi.
